TS#1 Location: Stratfield Road at/between Louvain Street and Bond Street. Nature of request: cars on Stratfield Road do not yield to pedestrians entering or in the crosswalk. Request ideally, a "Stop" sign on Stratfield Road, where the crosswalk is at the intersection of Stratfield/Louvain and Stratfield/Bond. Install a rapid rectangular flashing beacon or pedestrian crossing stanchion at the intersection of Stratfield/Louvain. By whom: Mr. Daniel Kasov. Recommendation: deny "Stop" sign on Stratfield Road, where the crosswalk is at the intersection of Stratfield /Louvain and Stratfield/Bond. Trim tree branches obstructing crosswalk sign at Stratfield/Louvain. RRFB to be discussed further.
TS #2 Location: Turney Road and Riverside Drive. Nature of request: "Stop" signs are not observed. Request to add a crosswalk and sign in the middle of the intersection and cut down the tree that blocks the "Stop" sign on Turney Road. By whom: Megann Dockum. Recommendation: crosswalk to be discussed further. Deny sign in the middle of the 4-way stop. Trim back tree that blocks "Stop" sign on Turney Road.
