T. S. #1 Location: Unquowa Road - Exit driveway at RLMS. Nature of request: request to add a crosswalk from the exit driveway at Roger Ludlowe Middle School across exit drive parallel with Unquowa Road. By whom: Angelus Papageorge - Fairfield Public Schools. Recommendation: Approve.

T. S. #2 Location: Kings Highway at New England Avenue. Nature of request: request lighting be approved along side of Kings Highway for pedestrians. Request a crosswalk at New England Avenue crossing Kings Highway. Reflective signs for traffic in advance of the crosswalk for both directions directing traffic to yield to pedestrians. By whom: Mr. Michael Dowling. Recommendation: Police Department to perform traffic study.

T. S. #3 Location: Sherley Place at/between Inwood Road. Nature of request: install "No Exit" sign or "Dead End" sign. By whom: Michael Noriega. Recommendation: Install "Dead End" sign in front of #120 Sherley Place.

T. S. #4 Location: Lenox Road/Blue Ridge Road between Waschuk Circle. Nature of request: install "No Parking" signs on one side of the street. This will allow more space for cars to drive safely through the curve. By whom: Robyn DeFonce. Recommendations: Install two (2) "No Parking" signs on curve on Blue Ridge Road just prior to Waschuk Circle with no parking arrows facing inward.
