SURVEY # 1 LOCATION: Wilson Street at/between Church Hill Road and Park Avenue

NATURE OF REQUEST:

Wilson Street is densely settled, exclusively residential street that serves as a feeder from Park Avenue to Stratfield Road. It bifurcates a residential neighborhood and is currently posted as 30 MPH. Given that the majority of the streets in Fairfield, if not all, which are of this characteristic are posted at 25 MPH.
