

FAIRFIELD BOARD OF POLICE COMMISSIONERS
REGULAR MEETING MARCH 10, 2021

The regular meeting of the Board of Police Commissioners was called to order by Chairman, Commissioner Millington at 4:32pm.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Motion made by Commissioner Pine to amend minutes from previous meeting. Traffic survey #1 needs the recommendation changed to read **10pm-6am** instead of 10-6pm. Motion seconded by Commissioner Ambrose; carried unanimously. Approval of minutes following the change motioned by Commissioner Millington; seconded by Commissioner Lebo; carried unanimously.

Old Business:

Rowland Road traffic survey requested by Alyssa Israel which was tabled from the February 10, 2021 Police Commission Meeting. Town Engineer William Hurley read from Section 3B.01 to clarify the warrants mandated in The Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD). **NATURE OF REQUEST:** 1. Consider not marking the road. 2. If it is determined that road is to be marked, to consider holding off on the restriping of Rowland Road until we can conduct a study to collect vehicle speed data to share with UConn for a traffic study. **RECOMMENDATIONS:** Use the two BlackCats to collect data for a total of two weeks. One week of monitoring prior to marking the road and a second week after the road is marked and look for the weather to be similar, if possible, for consistency. Motion on marking the road made by Commissioner Ambrose and seconded by Commissioner Lebo; carried unanimously. Motion on traffic survey with dates to be determined by the Police Department and Engineering Department made by Commissioner Pine and seconded by Commissioner Stone; carried unanimously.
