At 0105 hrs. Fairfield Police received an alarm for a Burglary in Progress at Luigi's Restaurant, 170 Post Rd. Responding officers observed a smashed front door and cash register missing. A perimeter was established by responding units. Officer Rubis located the cash register at a nearby property. Norwalk K-9 responded and tracked from that location, locating the suspect hiding on an adjacent property. The accused was also wanted by Fairfield Police for a similar crime in 2011. A quick, decisive and coordinated effort by all officers involved resulted in this highly successful outcome.








